



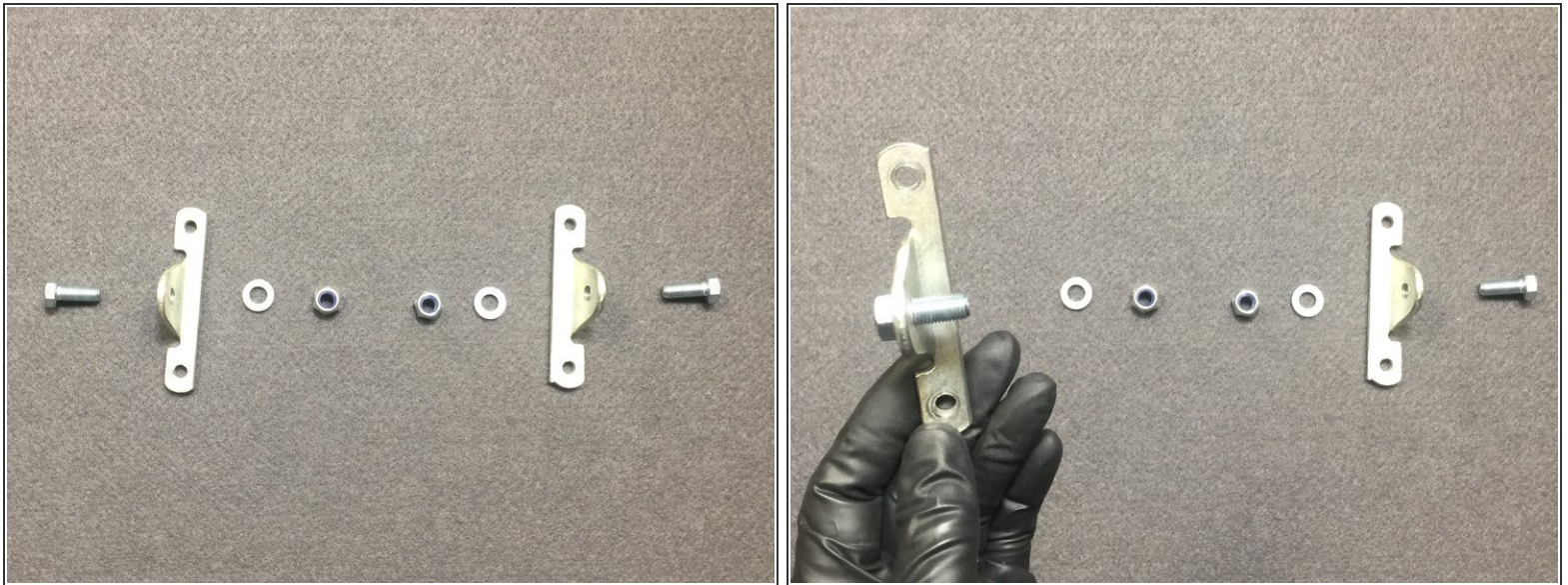
How to - Install Sidecar Windshield

A how to detailing the installation of a sidecar windshield.

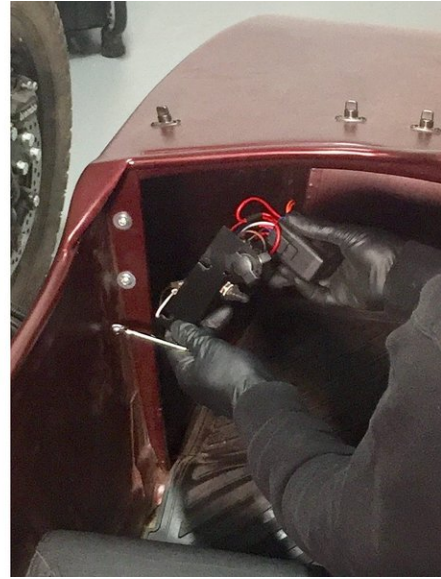
Step 1 — Assemble Left Sidecar Windshield Mount



- Assemble the left sidecar windshield mount as shown, tighten the left sidecar windshield pivot bolt enough that it will not back out of the left sidecar windshield mount when installed.

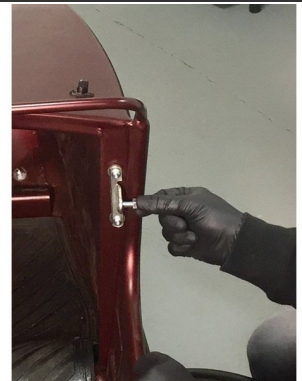
⚠ Note the orientation for both left and right sidecar windshield mounts. If not orientated properly functionality of the sidecar assembly and damage to the glazing from metal sidecar windshield frame will result.

Step 2 — Remove 12V Accessory Fuse Panel



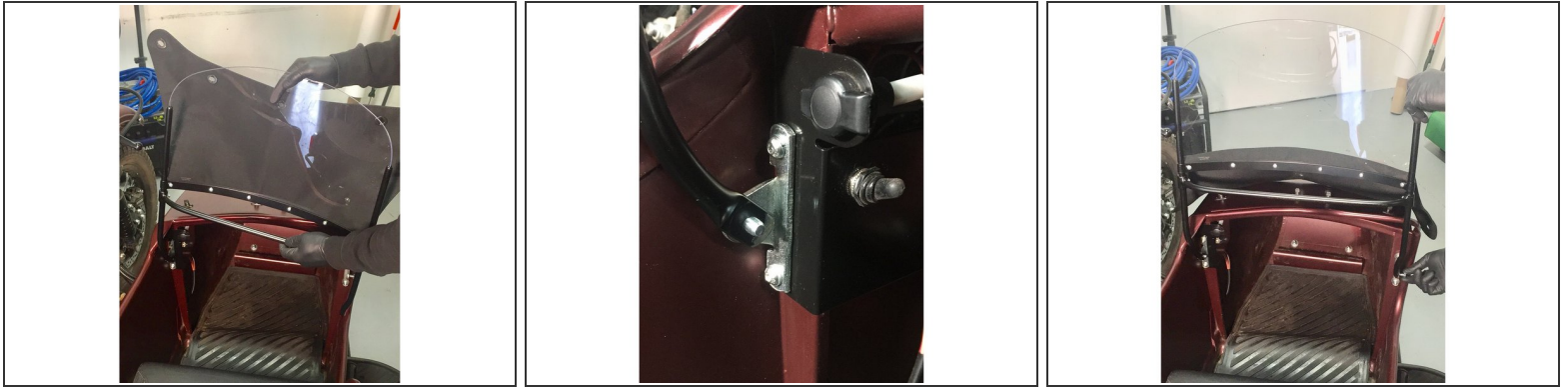
- If equipped, remove the two screws securing the 12V accessory fuse panel. Place the fuse panel to the side momentarily.

Step 3 — Install Sidecar Windshield Mounts



- Install the sidecar windshield mount assembled in Step 1 on the left side.
- If equipped and removed in Step 2, replace the 12V accessory fuse panel behind the left sidecar windshield mount before tightening completely,
- Install the right sidecar windshield mount and just start the threads of the sidecar windshield pivot bolt.

Step 4 — Install Sidecar Windshield To Mounts



- Slide the left sidecar windshield leg onto the left sidecar windshield mount pivot bolt.
- Hold the sidecar windshield in position and thread the right sidecar windshield pivot bolt through the right sidecar windshield mount and right sidecar windshield leg.

Step 5 — Complete Installation of Sidecar Windshield



- Tighten the right sidecar pivot bolt to the mount securely enough that it will not back out.
- Install the flat washer and nylock nut on to both left and right sidecar windshield pivot bolts.
- Tighten nylock nuts until one (1) to two (2) threads are visible just beyond the nylon locking ring, yet the sidecar windshield frame moves within the arc of movement freely without binding.
- Secure the sidecar windshield apron to the sidecar to hold the sidecar windshield in place.
- Take a passenger for a ride and enjoy your new sidecar windshield.
